Objective 2 Student Driven Sustainability Practices 2.4 Habitat Restoration

Fishing Creek clean up and shoreline protection; Spring 2014, and Fall/winter 2014. Involving members of the Lorax club and National Honor Society.

Students have helped install, plant, construct and maintain many habitat features of nearby Fishing Creek and the wooden walking trail that spans from the creek into two nearby neighborhoods.

In the spring of 2014, students helped with a clean-up effort, removing trash from the creek and scrubbing the oyster cages attached to the underside of the walkway crossing the creek.

Teams also laid rock on the edges of the creek to slow erosion and prevent silt from entering the waterway.
